Curriculum Plan for Summer Term 2009

Class Teachers: Miss Biggs / Mrs Johnson & Mrs Chapman

English	Listening carefully to stories and poems. Speaking and listening activities including sharing news, circle time and role play. Composing stories: structure, characters and setting. Use of dictionaries –alphabetical order. Phonic work including vowel blends and word endings. Letter formation.
Mathematics	Count in twos, fives and tens. Recognise odd and even numbers. Understand concepts of more and less in number. Addition and subtraction. Money: totals, selecting coins, change. Measure capacity in litres. Time: o' clock and half past. Symmetry. Use positional language.
Science	Topic: Plants. Examine different seeds. Plant a seed and monitor growth. Plants provide food for people. Plants can be living or artificial. Topic: Pushes and pulls. Investigate different types of movement. Topic: Sound and hearing. Explore different sources of sounds. Investigate sound travel.
Physical Education	Outdoor games: Learn the rules of rounders, practise skills and play as a team against opponents. Sports day practice. Dance: Respond to music. Remember and perform simple dance phrases. Gymnastics: Travel, jump and land with control on floor and apparatus.
Religious Education	Christianity: Stories Jesus told presented by CRIBS (Christian Resources in Bexley Schools). Judaism: Worship in a synagogue. Special clothes. The ark and the torah. Moses and the ten commandments. Ceremonies.

CREATIVE LEARNING JOURNEY

We are continuing our cross-curricular trial during the Summer Term using the Creative Learning Journey material developed by Bexley Schools. The children in Years 1 –6 will have separate English, Maths, RE and Science lessons but much of their learning in History, Geography, Art, Design, Technology and so on will take place within a topic which has been designed to make links to learning across the curriculum.
